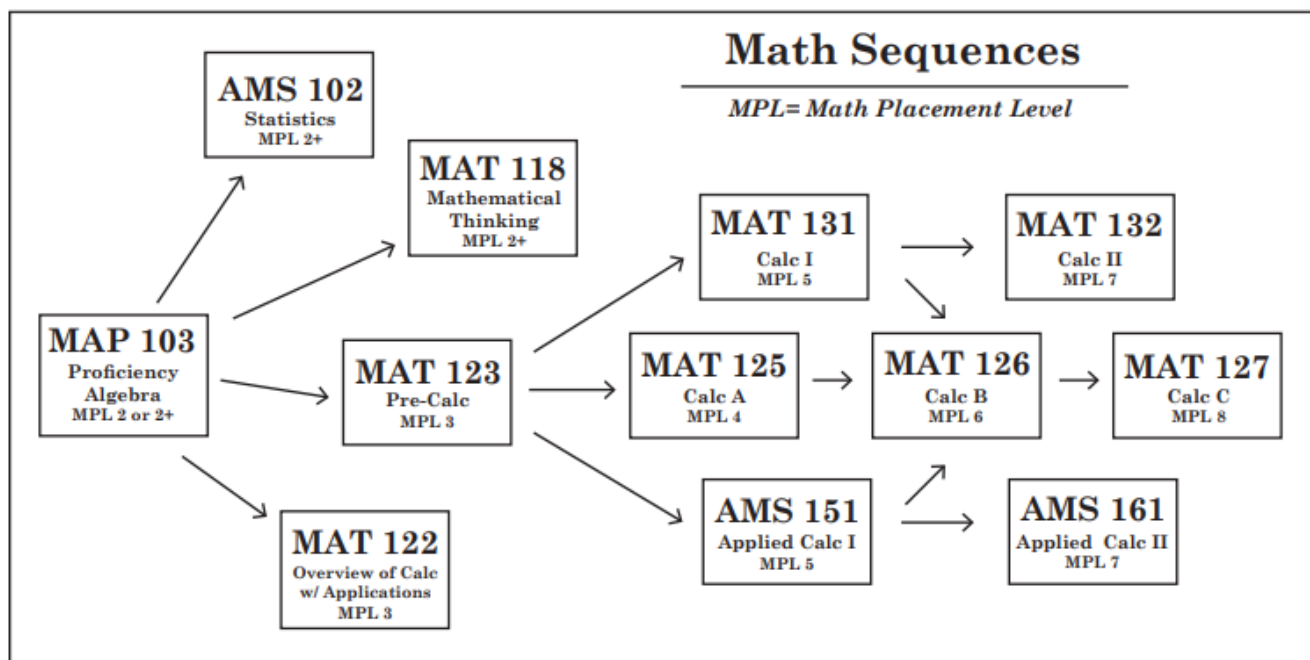

..... Chemistry Placement

The student must complete the OCPP prior to Orientation.

Students are required to score a 3 on the OCPP in order to place into CHE 129/130 or CHE 131.

... Foreign Language Placement ...

<i>Score</i>	<i>Result</i>	<i>Foreign Language Course</i>
none	Take two semester elementary foreign language course sequence	Enroll in a course sequence numbered 101, 111/112
1	Take two semester elementary foreign language course sequence	Enroll in a course sequence numbered 101, 111/112
2	Waives from first semester of elementary foreign language course sequence	Enroll in a course numbered 112
3	Satisfies foreign language requirement	None required for LANG fulfillment (qualified for 201 or 211)
4	Satisfies foreign language requirement	None required for LANG fulfillment (qualified for 212 in all languages except Spanish*)
5	Satisfies foreign language requirement	None required for LANG fulfillment (qualified for upper division)

***Students who score a 4 on the foreign language placement exam in Spanish should speak directly to the Spanish department for placement into upper division courses.**
