DEPT OF HISPANIC LANGUAGES AND LITERATURE

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN SPANISH LANGUAGE & LITERATURE (SPN)

All courses in Spanish offered to fulfill minor requirements must be passed with a letter grade of C or higher. At least nine credits of upper-division Spanish courses must be earned at Stony Brook to complete the minor.

Completion of the minor requires 18-24 credits. (see note 1 below)

- A. **Basic Spanish Language Courses**: SPN 211 Intermediate Spanish I, SPN 212 Intermediate Spanish II (6 credits, or the equivalent proficiency satisfied through permission of the department, or through the placement or the challenge exam).
- B. Required Basic Courses (9 credits)
 - SPN 311 Spanish Conversation and Composition
 OR SPN 310 Spanish Grammar and Composition for students of Hispanic-American background
 - SPN 312 Introduction to Literary Studies
 - SPN 321 Advanced Spanish Grammar and Composition

C. Advanced Elective Courses (9 credits) THREE other upper-division SPN courses, two of which must be at the 400 level.

Notes:

1. Those students with enough language proficiency to satisfy requirement A will complete a total of 18 credits. The students who need to take SPN 211 and 212 will complete a total of 24 credits.
