What is Ombuds Day?

- The American Bar Association (ABA) Dispute Resolution Section Launched Inaugural Ombuds Day, on October 11, 2018. This is part of a month-long recognition of conflict resolution professions. Ombuds Day this year is on October 10, 2024.
- Who does the Ombuds Office serve? Students, Faculty & Staff of Stony Brook University & Stony Brook Medicine.
- What can the Ombuds Office do for me? The ombuds provides an informal channel through which constituents (students, faculty and staff) can confidentially discuss concerns, complaints or seek information and referrals without fear of retaliation. The office provides <u>educational</u> <u>workshops</u> and online <u>Quick Tips</u> on topics such as communication, conflict resolution, and more.
