DR. ZEBULON VANCE MILETSKY SBU, ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF AFRICANA STUDIES

Dr. Miletsky will guide an interactive discussion weaving in the powerful biographical drama and the complex dynamics of racial justice, political resistance, and state surveillance in 1960s America.

Dr. Miletsky is an historian specializing in recent African-American History, Civil Rights and Black Power, Urban History, Mixed Race and Biracial identity, and Hip-Hop Studies. His research interests include: African-Americans in Boston: Northern freedom movements outside of the South; Mixed race history in the U.S. and passing; and the Afro-Latin diaspora.

JUDAS AND THE BLACK MESSIAH

"Judas and the Black Messiah" (2021) chronicles the true story of FBI informant William O'Neal's infiltration of the Illinois Black Panther Party and his betrayal of Chairman Fred Hampton, brilliantly portrayed by Daniel Kaluuya in his Oscarwinning performance. The film powerfully depicts Hampton's rise as a charismatic civil rights leader and his tragic assassination by law enforcement in 1969, while exploring themes of loyalty, revolution, and systemic racism through the complex dynamic between O'Neal (LaKeith Stanfield) and Hampton.
